

St. Susanna Religious Education 2020-2021

It is time to register your family for Religious Education! G.I.F.T (Growing In Faith Together) is a great opportunity educate your children about their faith. Especially now, it is important to understand how God works around us every day. As a staff we have come up with two options for Religious Education, and ask that you select an option for each child in your family.

PreK-5th grade classes: Sundays 10:30-11:15 am
6th-10th grade classes: Sundays 6:30-7:30 pm

**We ask that all families complete registration by
Monday, August 24.**

Option #1: On-Site/Blended

These weekly classes will be offered on-site with both students and catechists wearing masks and adhering to social distancing guidelines. Blended means that we have a few weekends when at home, family based catechesis will be the only lesson available (typically during extended breaks or holidays). Class materials will come and go home with students each week so that, in the event of student illness, family illness or exposure to COVID, the lessons can still be completed lessons at home.

This blend of on-site/at-home will also help if our staff determines a need to shut down the building for a time period, faith education can still be happening. We will provide support to these students and parents as needed.



Option #2: At-Home Only

The At-Home Option is for students/families that are not ready yet to return for in-person classes at St. Susanna. All families are an important part of our parish community. Just as the family's faith is important. Families choosing this option will receive all the same class materials and guidance for lessons. Elementary grades will receive a weekly email video that parents can use to work with the student as they cover each lesson. The middle and high school students will participate in small group discussions on Zoom Calls.
